HEART

PART I. CHARACTER OF HEART

A. QUANTITY OF HEART

1. One Heart

Acts 4:32 And the multitude of them that believe were of one **heart** and of one soul: neither said any of them ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

2 Chr 30:12 Also in Judah the hand of God was to give them one **heart** to do the commandment of the king and of the princes, by the word of the Lord.

Eze 11:19 And I will make them one **heart**, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony **heart** out of their flesh, and will give them an **heart** of flesh:

Jer 32:39 And I will give them one **heart**, and one way, that they may fear me for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them:

Ps 83:5 For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee.

2. All Your Heart

Mt 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy **heart**, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Mk 12:30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy **heart** and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

Mk 12:33 And to love him with all thy **heart** and with all thy understanding, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and to love his neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

Lk 10:27 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy **heart**, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbor as thyself.

Acts 8:37 And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine **heart**, thou mayest, And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Zep 3:14 Sing, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel; be glad and rejoice with all the **heart**, O daughter of Jerusalem.

Pr 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all thine **heart**; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

2 Chr 6:38 If they return to thee with all their **heart** and with all their soul in the land of their captivity, whither they carried them captives, and pray toward their land, which thou gavest unto thy fathers, and toward the city which thou hast chosen, and toward the house which I have built for thy name:

Jg 16:17 That he told her all his **heart**, and said unto her, There hath not come razor upon thy head; for I have been a Nazarite unto God from my mother's womb: if I have shaven, then my strength will go from me, and I shall become weak, and be like any other man.

Jg 16:18 And when Delilah saw that he had told her all his **heart**, she sent and called for the lords of the Philistines, saying, Come up this once, for he hath shewed me all his **heart**. Then the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and brought money in their hand.

2 Chr 6:14 And said, O Lord God of Israel there is no God like thee in the heaven, nor in the earth; which keepeth covenant, and shewest mercy unto thy servants, that walk before thee with all their **hearts**.

2 Kg 23:3 And the king stood by a pillar and made a covenant before the Lord to walk after the Lord, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all their **heart**, and with all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book, And all the people stood to the covenant.

1 Kg 8:23 And he said, Lord God of Israel, there is no God like thee, in heaven above, or on the earth beneath, who keepeth covenant and mercy with thy servants that walk before thee with all their **heart**:

3. Abundance of the Heart

Mt 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the **heart** the mouth speaketh.

4. Enlarged Heart

2 Cor 6:11 O ye Corinthians, our mouth is opened unto you, our **heart** is enlarged.

Ps 119:32 I will run the way of thy commandments, when thou shalt enlarge my **heart**.

5. Largeness of Heart

1 Kg 4:29 And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of **heart**, even as the sand that is on the sea shore.

6. Mighty Heart

Job 36:5 Behold, God is mighty, and despiseth not any: he is mighty in strength and wisdom.

B. HEART RESPONSE

1. Touched

1 Sa 10:26 And Saul also went home to Gibeah; and there went with him a band of men, whose **hearts** God had touched.

2. Heart exercised

2 Pe 2:14 Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: and **heart** they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children:

3. Stirred In Heart

Ex 35:21 And they came, every one whose **heart** stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the Lord's offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments.

Ex 35:26 And all the women whose **heart** stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' hair.

Ex 36:2 And Moses called Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise **hearted** man, in whose **heart** the Lord had put wisdom, even everyone whose **heart** stirred him up to come unto the work to do it:

Ps 38:8 I am feeble and sore broken: I have roared by reason of the disquietness of my **heart**.

4. Heart Exalted

Hos 13:6 According to their pasture, so were they filled; they were filled, and their **heart** was exalted; therefore have they forgotten me.

5. Heart Lifted Up

2 Chr 17:6 And his **heart** was lifted up in the ways of the Lord; moreover he took away the high places and groves out of Judah.

2 Chr 25:19 Thou sayest, Lo, thou hast smitten the Edomites; and thine **heart** lifted thee up to boast: abide now at home; why shouldst thou meddle to thine hurt, that thou shouldst fall, even thou, and Judah with thee?

2 Chr 26:16 But when he was strong, his **heart** was lifted up to his destruction: for he transgressed against the Lord his God, and went into the temple of the Lord to burn incense upon the alter of incense.

2 Chr 32:25 But Jezeiah rendered not again according to the benefit done unto him; for his **heart** was lifted up: therefore there was wrath upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem.

Eze 28:17 Thine **heart** was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.

6. Heart Filled

Jn 16:6 But because I have said these things unto you, sorrow hath filled your **heart**.

Acts 5:3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine **heart** to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?

Acts 14:17 Nevertheless he left himself without witness, in that he did good, and gave us rain from heaven, and fruitful seasons, filling our **hearts** with food and gladness.

Ex 35:35 Them hath he filled with wisdom of **heart**, to work all manner of work, of the engraver, and of the cunning workman, and of the embroiderer, in blue, and in purple, in scarlet, and in fine linen, and of the weaver, even of them that do any work, and of those that devise cunning work.

Eze 28:2 Son of man, say unto the prince of Tyrus, Thus saith the Lord God; Because thine **heart** is filled up, and thou hast said, I am a God, I sit in the seat of God, in the midst of the seas; yet thou art a man, and not God, though thou set thine **heart** as the **heart** of God:

Pr 14:14 The backslider in **heart** shall be filled with his own ways: and a good man shall be satisfied from himself.

7. Laid Them Up In Heart

Isa 57:1 The righteous persisteth, and no man layeth it to **heart**: and merciful men are taken away, none considering that the righteous is taken away from the evil to come.

Lk 1:66 And all them that heard them laid them up in their **hearts**, saying, What manner of child shall this be! And the hand of the Lord was with him.

Isa 57:11 And of whom hast thou been afraid or feared, that thou hast lied, and hast not remembered me, nor laid it to thy **heart**? have not I held my peace even of old, and thou fearest me not?

Jer 12:11 They have made it desolate, and being desolate it mourneth unto me; the whole land is made desolate, because no men layeth it to **heart**.

Ecc 7:2 It is better to go to the house of mourning, than to go to the house of feasting: for that is the end of all men; and the living will lay it to his **heart**.

8. Deep In Heart

Ps 64:6 They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward thought of every one of them and the **heart**, is deep.

9. Heart Fixed

Ps 57:7 My **heart** is fixed, O God my **heart** is fixed: I will sing and give praise.

Ps 112:7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his **heart** is fixed, trusting in the Lord.

Ps 108:1 O God, my **heart** is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory.

10. Heart Melts

Nah 2:10 She is empty, and void, and waste: and the **heart** melteth, and the knees smite together, and much pain is in all loins, and the faces of them all gather blackness.

Eze 21:7 And it shall be, when they say unto thee, Wherefore sighest thou? that thou shalt answer, For the tidings; because it cometh: and every **heart** shall melt, and all hands shall be feeble, and every spirit shall faint, and all knees shall be weak as water: behold, it cometh, and shall be brought to pass, saith the Lord God.

Jos 14:8 Nevertheless my brethern that went up with me made the **heart** of the people melt: but I wholly followed the Lord my God.

11. Give By Heart

Ex 25:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring me an offering: of every man that giveth it willingly with his **heart** ye shall take my offering.

Jer 3:15-17 And I will give you pastors according to mine **heart**, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding. And it shall come to pass, when ye be multiplied and increased in the land, in those days, saith the Lord, they shall say no more, The ark of the covenant of the Lord: neither shall it come to mind: neither shall they remember it; neither shall they visit it, neither shall that be done any more.

Pr 23:26 My son, give me thine **heart**, and let thine eyes observe my ways.

1 Sa 10:9 And it was so, that when he had turned his back to go from Samuel, God gave him another **heart**: and all those signs came to pass that day.

Jer 32:39 And I will give them one **heart**, and one way, that they may fear me for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them:

12. Daystar Arise In Heart

2 Pe 1:19 We have also a more sure word of prophesy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that Shinto in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise In your **hearts**:

C. PURE HEART

1. Pure In Heart

Mt 5:8 Blessed are the pure in **heart**: for they shall see God.

1 Pe 1:22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethern, see that ye love one another with a pure **heart** fervently:

Jas 4:8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your **hearts** ye double minded.

2 Ti 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace with them that call on the Lord out of a pure **heart**.

Pr 22:11 He that loveth pureness of **heart**, for the grace of his lips the king shall be his friend.

2. Perfect Heart

1 Chr 29:9 Then the people rejoice for that they offered willingly, because with perfect **heart** they offered willingly to the Lord: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy.

1 Chr 12:38 All these men of war, that could keep rank, come with a perfect **heart** to Heron, to make David king over all Israel: and all the rest also of Israel were of one **heart** to make David king.

Isa 38:3 And said, Remember now, O Lord, I beseech thee, how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect **heart**, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And He Sikh wept sore.

1 Chr 28:9 And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect **heart** and with a willing mind: for the Lord searcheth all **hearts**, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee, if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.

3. Proven Heart

Ps 17:3 Thou hast proved mine **heart**; thou hast visited me in the night; thou hast tried me, and shalt find nothing; I am purposed that my mouth shall not transgress.

4. Clean Heart

Ps 51:10 Create in me a clean **heart**, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.

Pr 20:9 Who can say, I have made my **heart** clean, I am pure from my sin?

5. Honest Heart

Lk 8:15 But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good **heart**, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.

6. Upright In Heart

Ps 7:10 My defense is of God, which saveth the upright in **heart**.

Ps 11:2 For, lo, the wicked bend their bow, they make ready their arrow upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the upright in **heart**.

Ps 32:11 Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy all ye that are upright in **heart**.

Ps 36:10 O continue thy lovingkindness unto them that know thee; and thy righteousness to the upright in **heart**.

Ps 64:10 The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in **heart** shall glory.

Ps 94:15 But judgment shall return unto righteousness: and all the upright in **heart** shall follow it.

Ps 97:11 Light is sown for the righteous, and gladness for the upright in **heart**.

Job 33:3 My works shall be of the uprightness of my **heart**: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly.

7. True And Sound Heart

Heb 10:22 Let us draw near with a true **heart** in full assurance of faith, having our **hearts** sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Jer 48:36 Therefore mine **heart** shall sound for Moab like pipes, and mine **heart** shall sound like pipes for the men of Kirheres: because the riches which he hath gotten are perished.

Ps 119:80 Let my **heart** be sound in thy statutes; that I be not ashamed.

Pr 14:30 A sound **heart** is the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.

8. Opened Heart

Acts 16:14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple of the city of Tyatira, which worshipped God, heard us: whose **heart** the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.

9. Good Heart

Lk 6:45 A good man out of the good treasure of his **heart** bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his **heart** bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the **heart** his mouth speaketh.

Lk 8:15 But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good **heart**, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience.

Mt 12:35 A good man out of the good treasures of his **heart** bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasures bringeth forth evil things.

10. Good or Bad Heart

Nu 24:13 If Balak would give me his house full of silver and gold, I cannot go beyond the commandment of the Lord, to do either good or bad of mine own mind; but what the Lord saith, that will I speak?

11. Unblameable Heart

1 Th 3:13 That the end he may establish your **hearts** unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints.

12. Nourished

Jas 5:5 Ye have lived on pleasure on the earth, and been wanton; ye have nourished your **hearts**, as in a day of slaughter.

13. Singleness Of Heart

Acts 2:46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat gladness and singleness of **heart**.

Eph 6:5 Servants, being obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your **heart**, as unto Christ;

Col 3:22 Servants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of **heart**, fearing God:

14. Confidence of Heart

1 Jn 3:21 Beloved, if our **heart** condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.

15. Subtle Heart

Pr 7:10 And, behold, there met him a woman with the attire of an harlot, and subtle of **heart**.

16. Sanctify Your Heart

1 Pe 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your **hearts**: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

17. Established With Grace

Heb 13:9 Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the **heart** be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.

D. Emotions And Heart

1. Gladness Of Heart

Acts 2:46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat gladness and singleness of **heart**.

Acts 14:17 Nevertheless he left himself without witness, in that he did good, and gave us rain from heaven, and fruitful seasons, filling our **hearts** with food and gladness.

Ps 4:7 Thou hast put gladness in my **heart**, more than in the time that their corn and wine increased.

Ps 97:11 Light is sown for the righteous, and gladness for the upright in **heart**.

Ps 16:9 Therefore my **heart** is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.

Pr 24:17 Rejoice not when the enemy falleth, and let not thine **heart** be glad when he stumbleth.

Pr 27:11 MY son, be wise and make my **heart** glad, that I may answer him that reproacheth me.

Ecc 7:3 Sorrow is better than laughter: for by the sadness of the countenance the **heart** is made better.

2 Chr 7:10 And on the three and twentieth day of the seventh month he sent the people away into their tents, glad and merry in **heart** for the goodness that the Lord had shewed unto David, and to Solomon and to Israel his people.

Ex 4:14 And the anger of the Lord was kindled against Moses, and he said, Is not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well, And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his **heart**.

1 Kg 8:66 On the eight day he sent the people away: and they blessed the king, and went into their tents joyful and glad of **heart** for all the goodness that the Lord had done for David his servant, and for Israel his people.

SOS 3:11 Go forth, O ye daughters of Zion, and behold king Solomon with the crown wherewith his mother crowned him in the day of his espousals, and in the day of the gladness of his **heart**.

Est 5:9 Then went Haman forth that day joyful and with a glad **heart**: but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, that he stood not up, nor moved for him, he was full of indignation against Mordecai.

Jg 18:20 And the priest's **heart** was glad, and he took the ephod, and the teraphim, and the graven image, and went in the midst of the people.

2. Joy Of Heart

Job 29:13 The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's **heart** to sing for joy.

Isa 65:14 Behold, my servants shall sing for joy of **heart**, but ye shall cry for sorrow of **heart**, and shall howl for vexation of spirit.

Ecc 5:20 For he shall not much remember the days of his life, because God answereth him in the joy of his **heart**.

Ecc 2:10 And whatsoever mine eyes desired I kept not from them, I withheld not my **heart** from any joy; for my **heart** rejoiced in all my labour: and this was my portion of all my labour.

Lam 5:15 The joy of your **heart** is ceased; our dance is turned into mourning.

1 Kg 8:66 On the eight day he sent the people away: and they blessed the king, and went into their tents joyful and glad of **heart** for all the goodness that the Lord had done for David his servant, and for Israel his people.

3. Peace of God In Heart

Col 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your **hearts**, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be thankful.

4. Love Of God In Heart

Ro 5:5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our **hearts** by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

2 Th 3:5 And the Lord direct your **heart** into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ.

5. Merry Heart

1 Sa 25:36 And Abigail came to Nabal; and, behold, he held a feast in his house, like the feast of a king; and Nabal's **heart** was merry within him, for he was very drunken: wherefore she told him nothing, less or more, until the morning light.

2 Sa 13:28 Now Absalom had commanded his servants, saying, Mark ye now when Amon's **heart** is merry with wine, and when I say unto you, Smite Amon; then kill him, fear not: have not I commanded you? be courageous, and be valiant.

Ecc 9:7 Go thy way, eat thy bread with joy, and drink thy wine with a merry **heart**; for God now accepteth thy works.

2 Chr 7:10 And on the three and twentieth day of the seventh month he sent the people away into their tents, glad and merry in **heart** for the goodness that the Lord had shewed unto David, and to Solomon and to Israel his people.

1 Kg 21:7 And Jezebel his wife said unto him, Dost thou now govern the kingdom of Israel? arise, and eat bread, and let thine **heart** be merry: I will give thee the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite.

Pr 15:13 A merry **heart** maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of **heart** the spirit is broken.

Pr 17:22 A merry **heart** doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.

Ru 3:7 And when Boaz had eaten and drunk, his **heart** was merry, he went to lie down at the end of the heap of corn: and she came softly and uncovered his feet, and laid her down.

Jg 16:25 And it came to pass, when their **hearts** were merry, that they said, Call for Samson, that he may make us sport. And they called for Samson out of the prison house; and he made them sport: and they set him between the pillars.

Jg 19:6 And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine **heart** be merry.

Jg 19:22 Now as they were making their **hearts** merry, behold, the men of the city, certain sons of Belial, beset the house round about, and beat at the door, and spake to the master of the house, the old man, saying, Bring forth the man that came into thine house, that we may know him.

Est 1:10 On the seventh day, when the **heart** of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Bizath, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king,

Isa 24:7 The new wine mourneth, the vine languisheth, all the merry**hearted** do sigh.

6. Comfort In Heart

2 Th 2:17 Comfort your **hearts**, and establish you in every good word and work.

Col 2:2 That their **hearts** might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and to the Father, and of Christ;

Jg 19:5 And it came to pass on the fourth day, when they arose early in the morning, that he rose up to depart: and the damsel's father said unto his son in law, Comfort thine **heart** with a morsel of bread, and afterward go your way.

Col 4:8 Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your **hearts**;

Ge 18:5 And I will fetch a morsel of bread, and comfort ye your **hearts**: after that ye shall pass on: for therefore are ye come to your servant. And they said, So do, as thou hast said.

2 Chr 30:22 And Hezekiah spake comfortably unto all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the Lord: and they did eat throughout the feast seven days, offering peace offerings, and making confession to the Lord God of their fathers.

7. Assurance In Heart

1 Jn 3:19 And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our **hearts** before him.

8. Stouthearted

Ps 76:5 The stouthearted are spoiled, they have slept their sleep; and none of the men of might have found their hands.

Isa 46:12 Hearken unto me, ye stouthearted, that are far from righteousness:

9. Valiant Hearted

2 Sa 17:10 And he also that is valiant, whose **heart** is as the **heart** of a lion, shall utterly melt: for all Israel knoweth that your father is a mighty man, and they which be with him are valiant men.

10. Contrite Heart

Ps 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: and a broken and a contrite **heart**, O God, thou wilt not despise.

Isa 57:15 For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and lofty place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the **heart** of the contrite ones.

11. Charity In Heart

1 Ti 1:5 Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure **heart**, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned;

12. Sorrow Of heart

Neh 2:2 Wherefore the king said unto me, Why is thy countenance sad, seeing thou art not sick? this is nothing else but sorrow of **heart**. Then I was very sore afraid,

Jn 16:6 But because I have said these things unto you, sorrow hath filled your **heart**.

Pr 14:13 Even in laughter the **heart** is sorrowful; and the end of that mirth is heaviness.

Ro 9:2 That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow of **heart**.

Pr 15:13 A merry **heart** maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of **heart** the spirit is broken.

Ecc 11:9-10 Rejoice, O young man, in thy youth: and let thy **heart** cheer thee in the days of thy youth, and walk in the ways of thy **heart**, and in the sight of thine eyes: but know thou, that for all these things God will

bring thee into judgment. Therefore, remove sorrow from thy **heart**, and put away evil from thy flesh: for childhood and youth are vanity.

Eze 13:22 Because with lies ye have made the **heart** of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life.

Lam 3:65 give them sorrow of **heart**, thy curse unto them.

13. Desolate In Heart

Ps 143:4 Therefore is my spirit overwhelmed within me; my **heart** within me is desolate.

14. Despair Of Heart

17. Bitterness Of Heart

Pr 14:10 The **heart** knoweth his own bitterness; and the end of that mirth is heaviness.

18. Pained In Heart

Ps 55:4 My **heart** is sore pained within me: and the terrors of death are fallen upon me.

19. Despised In Heart

1 Chr 15:29 And it came to pass, as the ark of the covenant of the Lord came to the city of David, that Michal, the daughter of Saul looking out at a window saw David dancing and playing: and she despised him in her **heart**.

Pr 3:12 And say, How have I hated instruction, and my **heart** despised reproof;

Pr 15:7 The lips of the wise despise knowledge: but the **heart** of the foolish doeth not so.

20. Trembling Heart

1 Sa 4:13 And when he came, lo, Eli sat upon a seat by the wayside watching: for his **heart** trembled for the ark of God. And when the man came into the city, and told it, all the city cried out.

1 Sa 28:5 And when Saul saw the host of the Philistines, he was afraid, and his **heart** greatly trembled.

Job 37:1 At this also my **heart** trembleth, and is moved out of his place.

De 28:65 And among these nations shalt thou find no ease, neither shall the sole of thy foot have rest: but the Lord shall give thee there a trembling **heart**, and falling eyes, and sorrow of mind:

Ex 35:29 The children of Israel brought a willing offering unto the Lord, every man and woman, whose **heart** made them willing to bring for all manner of work, which the Lord had commanded to be made by the hand of Moses.

2. Entered Into the Heart

Mk 7:19 Because it entereth not into his **heart**, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?

1 Cor 2:9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the **heart** of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

Pr 2:10 When wisdom entereth into thine **heart**, and knowledge is pleasant unto thy soul;

Ps 37:15 Their sword shall enter into their own **heart**, and their bows shall be broken.

3. Purposed In Heart

Acts 11:23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of **heart** they would cleave unto the Lord.

2 Cor 9:7 Every man according as he has purposed in his **heart**, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

Dan 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his **heart** that he would not defile himself with the portion of the kings meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.

4. Hearts Desires

Ro 10:1 Brethern, my **heart's** desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved.

Rev 17:17 For God hath put in your **hearts** to fulfill his will, and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.

5. Settled In Heart

Lk 21:14 Settle it therefore in your **hearts**, not to meditate before what ye shall answer:

6. Diligent Heart

Pr 4:23 Keep thy **heart** with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

G. COMMUNICATION AND HEART

1. Word in Heart

Mk 4:15 And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their **hearts**.

Lk 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their **hearts**, lest they should believe and be saved.

Mk 6:52 For they considered not the miracles of the loaves: for their **heart** was hardened.

2 Cor 3:2 Ye are our epistle in our **hearts**, known and read of all men:

2 Cor 3:3 Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshly tables of the **heart**.

3. Seeded & Troubled In Heart

Jn 14:1 Let not your **heart** be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

Jn 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your **heart** be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

2 Kg 6:11 Therefore the **heart** of the king of Syria was sore troubled at this thing; and he called his servants and said unto them, Will ye not show me which of us is for the king of Israel?

4. Law Written In Heart

Ro 2:15 Which shew the work of the law written in their **hearts**, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)

Ps 37:31 The law of his God is in his **heart**; none of his steps shall slide.

Isa 51:7 Hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose **heart** is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings.

Ge 6:6 And it repented the Lord that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him in his **heart**.

5. Preparations In Heart

Pr 16:1 The preparations of the **heart** in man, and the answer of the tongue, is from the Lord.

Hos 7:6 For they have made ready their **heart** like an oven, whiles they lie in wait: their baker sleepeth all the night; in the morning it burneth as a flaming fire.

2 Chr 12:14 And he did evil, because he prepared not his **heart** to seek the Lord.

Ps 10:17 Lord, thou hast heard the desire of the humble: thou wilt prepare their **heart**, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear.

6. Keep These Sayings

8. Devices In Heart

Pr 19:21 There are many devices in a man's **heart**; nevertheless the counsel of the Lord, that shall stand.

Pr 27:19 As in water face answereth to face, so the **heart** of man to man.

10. Song In Heart

Mt 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in **heart**: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

Eph 5:19 Speaking to yourselves in Psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your **heart** to the Lord;

11. Vail In Heart

2 Cor 3:15 But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their **heart**.

H. HEART PROBLEMS

1. Broken

Lk 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the broken-**hearted**, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Isa 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he sent me to bind up the broken**hearted**, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

Ps 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: and a broken and a contrite **heart**, O God, thou wilt not despise.

Ps 147:3 He healeth the broken in **heart**, and bindeth up their wounds.

Ps 34:18 The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken **heart**; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.

Ps 69:20 Reproach hath broken my **heart**; and I am full of heaviness: and I looked for some to take pity, and there was none; and for comforters, and I found none.

Acts 21:13 Then Paul answered, What mean ye to weep and to break mine **heart**? for I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus.

Jer 23:9 Mine **heart** within me is broken because of the prophets; all my bones shake; I am like a drunken man, and like a drunken man, whom wine has overcome, because of the Lord, and because of the words of his holiness.

2. Hardened Heart

Ex 4:21 And the Lord said unto Moses, When thou goest to return into Egypt, see that thou doest all these wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in thine hand: but I will harden his **heart**, that he shall not let the people go.

Ex 7:3 And I will harden Pharaoh's **heart**, and multiply my signs and my wonders in the land of Egypt.

Ex 7:13 And he hardened Pharaoh's **heart**, that he hearkened not unto them; as the Lord had said.

Ex 7:14 And the Lord said unto Moses, Pharaoh's **heart** is hardened, he refuseth to let the people go.

Ex 8:15 But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened his **heart**, and hearkened not unto them; as the Lord had said.

Ex 7:22 And the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and Pharaoh's **heart** was hardened, neither did he hearken unto them; as the Lord had said.

Ex 8:19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This is the finger of God: and Pharaoh's **heart** was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the Lord had said.

Ex 9:34 And when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and hardened his **heart**, he and his servants.

Ex 9:7 And Pharaoh sent, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the **heart** of Pharaoh was hardened and he did not let the people go.

Ex 9:12 And the Lord hardened the **heart** of Pharaoh, and he hearkened not unto them; as the Lord had spoken unto Moses.

Ex 9:32 And Pharaoh hardened his **heart** at this time also, neither would he let the people go.

Ex 9:35 And the **heart** of Pharaoh was hardened, neither would he let the children of Israel go; as the Lord had spoken by Moses.

Ex 10:1 And the Lord said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh: for I have hardened his **heart**, and the **heart** of his servants, that I might shew these signs before him.

Ex 10:20 But the Lord hardened Pharaoh's **heart**, so that he would not let the children of Israel go.

Ex 10:27 But the Lord hardened Pharaoh's **heart**, and he would not let them go.

Ex 11:10 And Moses and Aaron did all these wonders before Pharaoh: and the Lord hardened Pharaoh's **heart**, so that he would not let the children of Israel go out of his hands.

Ex 14:4 And I will harden Pharaoh's **heart**, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his hosts; that the Egyptians may know that I am the Lord. And they did so.

Ex 14:8 And the Lord hardened the **heart** of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued after the children of Israel: and the children of Israel went out with a high hand.

Ex 14:17 And I, behold, I will harden the **hearts** of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them: and I will get me honour upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.

Pr 28:14 Happy is the man that feareth alway: but he that hardeneth his **heart** falleth into mischief.

Eze 3:7 But the house of Israel will not hearken unto thee; for they will not hearken unto me: for all the house of Israel is impudent and hard**hearted**.

1 Sa 6:6 Wherefore then do ye harden your **hearts**, as the Egyptians and Pharaoh hardened their **hearts**? when he had wrought wrongfully among them, did they not let the people go, and they departed?

Jos 11:20 For it was of the Lord to harden their **hearts**, that they should come against Israel in battle, that he might destroy them utterly, and that they might have no favour, but that he might destroy them, as the Lord commanded Moses.

Heb 4:7 Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye hear his voice, harden not your **hearts**.

Heb 3:8 Harden not your **hearts**, as in the provocation in the day of temptation in the wilderness.

Heb 3:15 While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your **hearts**, as in the provocation.

Mk 8:17 And when Jesus knew it, he saith unto them Why reason ye, because ye have no bread? perceive ye not yet, neither understand? have ye your **heart** yet hardened?

Jn 12:40 He hath blinded their eyes and hardened their **hearts**; that they should not see with their eyes, nor understand with their **heart**, and be converted, and I should heal them.

Ro 2:5 But after thy hardness and impenitent **heart** treasured up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;

3. Stony Hearts

Zec 7:12 Yea, they made their **hearts** as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the Lord of Hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came a great wrath from the Lord of hosts.

Job 41:24 His **heart** is as firm as a stone; yea, as hard as a piece of the neither millstone.

4. Impenitent Heart

Ro 2:5 But after thy hardness and impenitent **heart** treasured up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;

5. Heavy Heart

Ro 9:2 That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow of **heart**.

Pr 12:25 Heaviness in the **heart** of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad.

Pr 25:20 As he that taketh away a garment in cold weather, and as vinegar upon nitre, so is he that singeth songs to a heavy **heart**.

6. Smitten Heart

Ps 102:4 My **heart** is smitten, and withered like grass; so that I forget to eat my bread.

7. Afflicted Heart

2 Cor 2:4 For out of much affliction and anguish of **heart** I wrote unto you with many tears; not that ye should be grieved, but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you.

Lam 3:33 For he doth not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men.

8. Wounded Heart

Ps 109:22 For I am poor and needy, and my **heart** is wounded within me.

9. Blindness in Heart

Eph 4:18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their **heart**:

10. Snares & Nets In Heart

Ecc 7:26 And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose **heart** is snares and nets, and her hands as bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape her; but the sinner shall be taken by her.

11. Unbelief In Heart

Heb 3:12 Take heed, brethern, lest there be in any of you an evil **heart** of unbelief, in departing from the living God.

12. Darkened Heart

Ro 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but because vain in their imaginations and their foolish **heart** was darkened.

13. Uncircumcised Heart

Acts 7:51 Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in **heart** and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye.

Ro 2:29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the **heart**, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.

14. Fat Heart

Ps 119:70 Their **heart** is a fat as grease; but I delight in thy law.

15. Slow Heart

Lk 24:25 Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of **heart** to believe all that the prophets have spoken:

16. Soft Heart

Job 23:16 For God maketh my **heart** soft and the Almighty troubleth me.

17. Void Heart

Hos 10:2 Their **heart** is divided; now shall they be found faulty: he shall break down their altars, he shall spoil their images.

9. Heart Died

Jer 4:9 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord, that the **heart** of the king shall perish, and the **heart** of the princes; and the priests shall be astonished, and the prophets shall wonder.

10. Abominations

1 Kg 4:29 And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of **heart**, even as the sand that is on the sea shore.

SOS 3:11 Go forth, O ye daughters of Zion, and behold king Solomon with the crown wherewith his mother crowned him in the day of his espousals, and in the day of the gladness of his **heart**.

2 Chr 9:23 And all the kings of the earth sought the presence of Solomon, to hear his wisdom, that God had put in his **heart**.

9. Jacob And The Heart

Ge 45:26 And told him, saying, Joseph is yet alive, and he is governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's **heart** fainted, for he believed them not.

10. Hezekiah And The Heart

2 Chr 32:26 Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his **heart**, both he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the Lord came upon them in the days of Hezekiah.

2 Chr 32:25 But Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit done unto him; for his **heart** was lifted up: therefore there was wrath upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem.

2 Chr 30:22 And Hezekiah spake comfortably unto all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the Lord: and they did eat throughout the feast seven days, offering peace offerings, and making confession to the Lord God of their fathers.

J. Heart Not Decline
